- The Town Hall is unavailable for most Fridays in April, so Bedford Square will host the Charter market on these days, this will see some housed in the large white marquee and some in individual ones.
- After taking ownership of Tavi Arts Market, we are now holding discussions to split the event between Bedford Square and Butchers' Hall, this would see it held on the square from May to August and then in Butchers' Hall from September to December.
