WORKS DEPARTMENT MONTHLY REPORT from 27.04.18 to 15.06.18

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Properties:

- **Guildhall** –Leak detection system in Guildhall actioned and survey completed in January, report received 08/02/18. Awaiting feedback from new insurers re: requirements due to planned mechanical and electrical upgrade as part of HLF Project.
- Cemetery Lodge Contract has now been completed and account finalised.
- Repair of the bay window in the Council Chamber Westcountry Stonemasons Ltd has been contracted to undertake the a full repair including scaffolding, stone repair, lead work, repointing and reinstatement for the sum of £8,260 ex VAT. Works planned for end August 2018 on receipt of LBC.
- Abbey Chapel Specification for the work drawn up with a view to undertaking the work in June 2018.
- Contract for Molly Owen Centre let works currently underway
- Repairs to windows at 14 Duke Street pending subject to agreeing access arrangements.
- Pannier Market Public Realm Contract re-let deadline 2nd July.
- **Fires extinguishers** across all site have been serviced and replaced as necessary and new stand have been purchased for the Pannier Market
- LEV testing at Molly Owen Centre has been done, remedial works planned.
- **6-monthly LOLER inspection** (lifting operations & lifting equipment operations) scheduled for 21st June.

Maintenance:

- **Play Parks** Regular (fortnightly) inspections, maintenance and repairs on-going. Installation of 'wet pour' safety surface for play equipment in the Meadows has been completed and contract being finalised. The annual RoSPA safety inspection took place on 1st June 2018 for all sites.
- Potholes minor repairs being undertaken, including car parks on Whitchurch Down, Guildhall, Pixon Lane open space and cobbles around Pannier Market.
- **Benches** on-going repairs and maintenance.
- Properties clearance works to rainwater goods on Town Hall, Guildhall, Butchers Hall and Duke Street on-going. RWGs replaced to Poppies Café.
- Quotes have been sought for the inspection/servicing of all TTC owned street lights (contract let), awaiting report.
- Bannawell clearance work and reinstatement of all access paths and footbridges ongoing with second bridge non-slip surfacing installed.
- **14 Duke Street** redundant sink in the basement has been disconnected and water charges cancelled.
- Repairs to door furniture to Guildhall undertaken.

Land Management:

- WDBC Maintenance Contract on-going
- Spraying continues on all areas. Works programmed to treat Japanese knotweed and Himalayan balsam on river bank of Pearce Meadow.
- **Tree Survey & Tree works** New planting along Cherry walk in the Meadows has been completed with on-going watering and monitoring.
- Whitchurch Down Consultative Group meeting was held on 2nd May. Gorse cutting, including clearing area around Pixies Cross, scheduled for September 2018. Safety signs and fencing to be repaired at Pennycomequick Quarry. Pedestrian Gate at Westmoor Park has been repaired.
- Hanging baskets watering contract with Tavistock BID now underway. All hanging baskets have been collected and erected on behalf of BID and on TTC land, including planting on Town Hall front elevation.
- **Proposed Callington Road Development Design Review Panel** The Works Administrator contributed to the Design Review Panel held on 29th April.
- RHS It's Your Neighbourhood judging takes place on 2nd July.
- **Tree work** planned for Plymouth Road Cemetery, Sensory Garden, Molly Owen Centre and Meadows mainly removal of dead, dying or diseased trees.

Cemeteries:

- Analysis of the soil heap has been completed and a geotechnical report has been received from Frederick Sherrell Ltd.
- One of the new cemetery signs for Dolvin Road requires a frame constructing before being positioned.
- Since 27/04/18 there have been 5 Full Burial Interment, 4 Green Burial Interments and 4 Ashes Interments. The Chapel has not been used.
- 18 monthly Monumental Inspections are 100% complete.
- Green Burial Area has been entered into the RHS 'It's Your Neighbourhood Awards'. Judging tales place on 2nd July.
- 5mph signs have arrived on site and will be installed by the end of June.

Projects:

Sensory Garden – Discussions on-going with project community group. Repairs to the damaged shed on-going. Agreement reached regarding removal of shrubs in Rose Walk, repairs to the access footpath and redecoration of the metal framing.

Events:

Goose Fair

- First operational meeting was held at the beginning of June and went well. It was agreed a second meeting was not required until September.
- Stallholder invoice due to be issued in June with a payment deadline of 31st August.
- New stallholder applications have been received
- The park and ride site at Lumburn Rise needs to be reviewed due to a potential sale to developers. The MDO is in talks with Ward and Chowen who are facilitating the land disposal.
