# MONTHLY REPORT from 17.03.18 to 26.04.18

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### **Properties:**

- **Guildhall** -Leak detection system in Guildhall actioned and survey completed in January, report received 08/02/18.
- **Cemetery Lodge** Contract has now been completed.
- Repair of the bay window in the Council Chamber Westcountry Stonemasons Ltd has been contracted to undertake the a full repair including scaffolding, stone repair, lead work, repointing and reinstatement for the sum of £8,260 ex VAT.
- Abbey Chapel Specification for the work drawn up with a view to undertaking the work in May 2018.

### **Maintenance:**

- **Play Parks** Regular (fortnightly) inspections, maintenance and repairs on-going. Installation of 'wet pour' safety surface for play equipment in the Meadows will commence 30<sup>th</sup> April. The annual RoSPA safety inspection is due to take place May/early June 2018.
- Potholes minor repairs being undertaken, including car parks on Whitchurch Down, Guildhall, Pixon Lane open space and cobbles around Pannier Market.
- **Benches –** on-going repairs and maintenance.
- **Properties** clearance works to rainwater goods on Town Hall, Guildhall, Butchers' Hall and Duke Street on-going
- !6 Duke Street basement drainage concerns being investigated and 17/18 Duke Street rear rwgs clearance works undertaken.
- Quotes have been sought for the inspection/servicing of all TTC owned street lights (contract let).
- Bannawell clearance work and reinstatement of all access paths and footbridges ongoing.

#### **Land Management:**

- **WDBC Maintenance Contract** on-going
- **Tree Survey & Tree works –** New planting along Cherry walk in the Meadows has been completed.
- Whitchurch Down –Gorse cutting, including clearing area around Pixies Cross, scheduled for September 2018.
- Hanging baskets BID has confirmed that TTC will be contracted to water the erect and water the hanging baskets in 2018. Hanging baskets will be in place week before the Garden festival (w/c 21st May).
- **Proposed Callington Road Development Design Review Panel** The Works Administrator contributed to the Design Review Panel held on 29<sup>th</sup> April.

### **Cemeteries:**

- Analysis of the soil heap is being undertaken by Frederick Sherrell week commencing 30<sup>th</sup>
   April with a view to investigating the most appropriate means of management and/or disposal.
- One of the new cemetery signs for Dolvin Road requires a frame constructing before being positioned.
- Since 17/03/18 there have been 1 Full Burial Interment and 4 Ashes Interments. The Chapel has not been used.
- 18 monthly Monumental Inspections are 100% complete.
- Visitors are still driving on the new grass/mud verges which are being continually repaired.
- I have met with an interested resident to discuss the progression of the Green Meadow Project. We are considering additional works to commence in April or from Autumn time.

**Sensory Garden** – Discussions on-going with project community group. Repairs to the damaged shed complete.
