#### **General Update**

- There will no trading in the Town Hall or Butchers' Hall on the week commencing 14<sup>th</sup> May; this will be the dedicated to the relocation of traders back into the Pannier Market, although we will offer Bedford Square trading to those who wish to trade.
- With the Pannier Market roofing works now complete, we are on schedule to re-open on our Charter Market day on Friday 18<sup>th</sup> May 2018.
- On the build up to the re-opening we are currently look at slight alterations to table mapping, this will involve creating wider more open archways and more consistency around the flow of footfall.
