1. An election of Town Councillors is to be held for Tavistock Town Council (North Ward)
2. Nomination papers may be obtained from the office of the Returning Officer at Kilworthy Park, Tavistock, Devon, PL19 0BZ, or from the Tavistock Town Clerk, during normal office hours.
3. Nomination papers must be hand delivered to the Returning Officer, West Devon Borough Council, Kilworthy Park, Tavistock, Devon, PL19 0BZ on any day after the date of this notice, Monday to Friday, between the hours of 10am and 4.00pm, but no later than by 4.00 pm on Friday, 22 June 2018.
4. If any election is contested the poll will take place on Thursday, 19 July 2018.
5. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 12 midnight on Tuesday, 03 July 2018. Applications can be made online at www.gov.uk/register tovot e or by completing a form which is available from the Elections Office, West Devon Borough Council, Kilworthy Park, Tavistock, Devon, PL19 0BZ.
6. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes and amendments or cancellations of proxy votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at West Devon Borough Council, Kilworthy Park, Tavistock, Devon, PL19 0BZ by 5.00pm on Wednesday, 04 July 2018.
7. New applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at West Devon Borough Council, Kilworthy Park, Tavistock, Devon, PL19 0BZ by 5.00pm on Wednesday, 11 July 2018.
8. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at West Devon Borough Council, Kilworthy Park, Tavistock, Devon, PL19 0BZ by 5.00 pm on Thursday, 19 July 2018. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5.00pm on Wednesday, 11 July 2018. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5.00pm on Wednesday, 11 July 2018.
