# 2. Civic Service\*

### 10. Property Units Update

There currently have no vacant residential properties.

- **15 Pannier Market** a new tenant has taken on a Lease on this unit, and the premises have recently re-opened.
- **3 East End Stores** will be utilised as a welfare facility for the contractors during the forthcoming Pannier Market Public Realm works. Marketing of the unit is ongoing in the anticipation of a new tenant being identified to take the property as soon as it is available.

We have received a request for the unit to be used as a 'pop up' shop in the run up to Christmas, negotiations are currently ongoing on this proposition.

- **5 East End Stores** a new tenant has taken on a Lease on this unit with effect from 15<sup>th</sup> August 2018. It is expected the shop will re-open shortly, if it hasn't already done so
- **11.** <u>General including ongoing activities in the Admin Office</u> the Office continues to support the organisation across the range of Civic, administrative, financial and corporate activities. A report on office staffing was submitted to the Budget & Policy Committee, and subsequently ratified at Full Council on 31<sup>st</sup> July 2018. Permanent recruitment into the Administration Office will commence in September 2018.
