PANNIER MARKET

1. General Update

- a) For the new financial year, we have endeavoured to be more diverse with our advertising and marketing, this includes targeting the Plymouth demographic a little more, we have also teamed up with a few of the trader's advertising group to deliver some more frequent Social Media posts, this has involved profiling featured traders throughout the week. We have also once again signed up to The Tavistock Times Gazette's Business club, this gives a weekly presence in the local paper or further afield should we wish, this is designed to be utilised across the whole of the Organisation.
- b) May has proved to have had a good volume of footfall including many tourists, this has been despite some challenges with the weather. In a recent torrential downpour, the market and south side surround become flooded in a matter of minutes, however with good team work from staff and traders, the damage was able to be kept at a minimum.
- c) With the Spring Country show now out of the way, we will start to focus on promotion of our Summer Monday openings, and our Summer trail. This years trail as previously reported will be an Olympic themed one, and will involve children having to hunt down sporty clues within the market to win a prize. These fun family activities have become an integral part of promoting the Pannier Market in a positive light, and ensuring our customers have a great experience when visiting, this is a completely free offer and will finish with an Olympic themed fun day. d) As discussed in point 1a, we are looking to draw more people to Tavistock from the Plymouth area, another initiative we have been involved in, was a joint venture with Visit Tavistock and the Plym Links Magazines. This was a four-page spread in Plym Links North, Plym

Links Central & Plym Links Coastal. Tavistock Town Council had a double page spread that featured an array of our commercial and community offers such as, the Guild Hall, Town Hall, Butchers Hall, Goose Fair and a selection of Pannier Market traders, with all four pages of the feature focused on all the excellent reasons to Visit Tavistock.

2. Bedford Square/Events

- a) The vast volume of rain hasn't fully dampened the spirits of the Bedford Square traders, with us continuing to have healthy volumes of activity including, Street Food events, Farmers Markets and the day to day activity of the regular traders.
