TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC ORDER 2019

NOTICE is hereby given that Devon County Council has made the above titled order.

The order came into force on 2nd October 2019 and would have expired on 2nd April 2021.

By direction of the Secretary of State in exercise of his powers under Section 15(5) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the order shall continue in force until **Saturday, 2nd October 2021** or until works have been completed, whichever is sooner.

No persons shall proceed on the section of the affected path except for access to land or premises on or adjacent to that length of path.

Public rights of way affected:

FOOTPATH NO. 3, TAVISTOCK across land adjacent to New Launceston Road.

An alternative route will be provided by the developer but will vary during phases of development.

The closure is necessary to enable housing development works to be completed.
