PANNIER MARKET

1. General Update

- a) The Pannier Market has seen a steady footfall over the festive period so far, with consistent attendance during key trading days. Despite the usual seasonal fluctuations, the market has maintained a solid number of visitors, suggesting continued interest in local produce and festive offerings. Both regular and seasonal vendors have reported positive sales, and the atmosphere has remained lively. As the festive season progresses, the market expects to maintain this steady level of traffic, with the final trading days anticipated to see a slight increase in visitors as Christmas approaches.
- b) Although the recent bad weather has affected outside trading in general, the Friday Charter Market continues to be well supported with both traders and customers, with us having regular new enquiries regarding trading. We will see a slight drop off during the notoriously quieter months where we will have reduced numbers, then look to relaunch in early Spring. Together with Tavistock BID, we have discussed having larger seasonal quarterly Charters as we look to turn Fridays into a must visit day for Tavistock.
- c) The festive additional markets events have proved successful, attracting steady footfall and creating a vibrant, festive atmosphere. Shoppers were drawn to the variety of stalls, with an appealing mix of local crafts, seasonal treats, and unique gifts, contributing to a lively, community-focused environment. The market's seasonal offerings were well-received, and the overall mood was one of enjoyment, ensuring a positive experience for both traders and visitors alike. This successful run of markets highlights the ability to adapt and enhance its appeal during the festive season.
- d) Voting has now closed for the NABMA market of the year awards, and the voting committee have a zoom meeting on 6th January to choose the shortlisted markets in their respective categories. We have been very pleased and grateful from the response from all of those that have voted, we will report progress as and when we hear.

2. Bedford Square/Events

a) With the return next year of the ever-popular Street Food events, the 2025 dates are now confirmed as;

The Farmers Markets have now concluded for 2024, with it being a successful year of trading without any operational issues, with some of the traders displaying an interest in also trading on our Friday Charter Market. 2025 dates will be made available once they have been received.
